Every Monday morning, our church staff meets at 11 am. We start our meetings each week praying for everyone on our prayer list. We give updates, if we have any. We share new prayer requests. Each and every week, the prayer list is included in the eNews and the bulletin. I pray that you, too, are taking the time to pray for each and every person named on the list. Praying for people grieving the loss of a loved one. Praying for people experiencing chronic illness, going through cancer treatments, or recovery from a surgery. As part of our prayer on Mondays, we pray that God will offer comfort, peace, healing, and rest as only God can. And we also pray that the Holy Spirit will guide us to know how best to offer tender loving care in each circumstance. Each week, it feels as though our prayer list is growing. New names are being added: new hurts, new pains, new illnesses, new grief. Keep praying for each other. Keep seeking ways that the Holy Spirit may guide you to show up for the people on this list. Send a card, send a text, give a phone call, offer to visit. This is what it is to be in faith community together. No one should ever be alone when they are going through something hard. Nor should one person be relied upon to always be the one person to show up when

needed. If you are going throughout your day, and someone comes to your mind and heart, say a prayer and check in on them. If you are going through your day and things feel hard and heavy and overwhelming, say and prayer and tell somebody. To be the church is to show up for one another. You are so loved!

# **Kids Sunday School**

At the top of the stairs, before you get to the balcony, you will find the Kindergarten through Second Grade Sunday School Class. It is led by teachers Megan Anderson, Bonnie Cheshire, and Mary Jane P.. Our regular attendees are Caroline, Raegan, Sarah, Teddy and Owen.

We have been using the Shine: Living in God's Light curriculum published by Brethren Press and MennoMedia. Weekly lessons begin with a Connect to Each Other activity. The opening activity is followed with an introduction to various types of prayers as we emphasize ways to Connect to God. Each week we work on a Bible memory verse as we Connect to the Bible.

During the year from September 2023 through May 2024, we will have studied both Old and New Testament stories. A children's Bible entitled <u>The Peace Table</u> has been used to illustrate and tell the weekly lesson. This year's studies have included these themes: The Family of Abraham and Sarah, Journey to Freedom (stories from Exodus), Advent and Christmas, Following Jesus, Lent and Easter and the Early Church (stories from Acts).

Around 10:30 each Sunday, Mrs. Susan D. meets with the children for music practice. The children are always excited when it's time to share their Christmas play or songs with the congregation. After students return to the classroom, Sunday School ends with a departing prayer.






## Softball
